## **MISSIONARY UPDATE**

*As I (Linda) sit here in Amman, preparing to return to Jerusalem in a few days, I think about you and how much you care for the message of Jesus and his salvation to go out to the world. I think about how you have participated alongside us both in prayer and finances as the Body of Christ to minister to people we hope will one day join us in heaven with Jesus. These thoughts give me tears of joy and thanksgiving. You are the beautiful Body of Christ.*

*We are so thankful for the opportunity to attend and participate in the wedding of our daughter Abby to Max O. on July 20<sup>th</sup> in Venice, Italy. The wedding was small so that both sides of the family could meet and get to know each other.*

*The longer this war lasts in Israel, the more personal it becomes. We have met Israelis who are terrified from Hamas. We meet Palestinians who just want to work and live in peace—who are now jobless because of Hamas. We meet soldiers and their families who are war weary. We talk to Israelis who are fed up with Israeli politics and want peace with Palestinians. And now, we meet Syrian refugees, through voice messages, who are new believers in Christ, who are living in fear of bombs and fire because of Hezbollah.*

*Our hearts are heavy, but we serve a powerful and faithful God! We are looking forward to seeing what He is going to do. There is a feeling of anticipation in our spirits. God is about to do something new. Thank you for joining us in this season of the Kingdom of Christ! We love you.*
